


Ease of Doing Business: Business Reform Action Plan



Business Reform Action Plan (BRAP) - Series of Central Government reforms to improve investment environment.

• Emphasis laid on simplification and rationalization of the existing rules and introduction of information technology in governance.

- In 2017 BRAP survey assessed and ranked 36 States and Union Territories (UTs) on the implementation of 372 business reforms and G2B feedback received on 72 reforms.
- Kerala has secured 21st position, with a final implementation score of 44.8 %, an increase of 18 % in the implementation score over the last year.
- The increase in the implementation score can be attributed to the various reform measures being implemented by the State Government.





Kerala: NCAER - State Investment Potential Index 2018






States Performance on the Six Broad Pillars






