

INVITING EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FROM COMPANIES/FIRMS FOR SETTING UP PLASTIC AND E-WASTE RECYCLING PROJECTS AT INDUSTRIAL GROWTH CENTRES OF KSIDC.

KSIDC seeks Expression of Interest (EOI) from companies/firms to establish plastic & e-waste recycling projects in the land available with Industrial Growth centres of KSIDC at Alappuzha, Kozhikode and Kannur districts. KSIDC has earmarked an extent of 10 acres of land in each IGCs for establishing recycling projects and in this regard, a special scheme has been framed for allotment of land at concessional rates with 5 years period to pay the lease premium. The details are given below:

Background of the scheme

With an aim to make India clean, the Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) was launched by the Government of India on 2nd October 2014. One of the key goals of the Mission is to achieve 100% scientific processing of municipal solid waste (MSW). According to the Integrated Solid Waste Management (ISWM) hierarchy, recovery and recycling is preferred waste management strategy after source reduction and reuse. Recovery of the recyclables should be adopted before planning for any waste processing or treatment facilities. Non-biodegradable waste such as plastic, paper, metal, glass, e-waste etc should be recycled separately in the individual recycling plant. One of the key factors is setting up plastic/e-waste recycling plants is availability of appropriate land for recycling projects. Therefore, 10 acres of land has been earmarked in Industrial Growth Centres (IGC) in Kannur (Valiyavelicham), Kozhikode (Kinalur) and Alappuzha (Cherthala) for setting up said re-cycling projects. All these IGCs have support infrastructure facilities such as power & water. KSIDC also ensures timely clearances for setting up the projects.

About the scheme

In order to promote and facilitate plastic and e-waste recycling projects, following scheme is launched by KSIDC:

- i. 25% reduction in applicable lease premium for allotment of land in IGCs of KSIDC at Alapuzha, Kozhikode and Kannur districts
- ii. Lease premium is payable within 5 years from the date of allotment. 40% of lease premium is payable as upfront and balance 60% lease premium in 5 equal annual (12% each) instalments without any interest
- iii. As per GO (Rt) No.727/2019/ID dt 5/8/2019, Interest Subvention Scheme for deferred instalment of land value is launched to attract new investors in Industrial parks. Interest @9% for the deferred instalments will be met by Govt through budgetary allocation to DIC. The above terms of payment are in line with the Scheme approved by Govt.
- iv. The land as per the scheme will be allotted only for plastic/e-waste recycling projects. Necessary conditions in this regard shall be incorporated in license and lease agreements. (Examples of plastic recycling projects include manufacture of

plastic granules/lumps/chips, plastic shredding and e-waste recycling projects include recycling, dismantling & refurbishing)
